With its pristine ocean beaches, beautiful coastal lakes and arms reach of many fun and interesting attractions Merimbula makes an ideal place for your next holiday escape.

## **DAY 1: Monday 6 May 2019 (MT, L, D)**

Today we depart to the South Coast to commence our journey to the enchanting seaside town of Merimbula. After boarding our luxury coach we make our way to the Hawkesbury River for morning tea before we continue to Bald Hill lookout to see the grand views of Seacliff Bridge and the stunning beaches below. After a delicious lunch overlooking the greens at Wollongong Golf Club we travel south to the entrance of the Clyde River for our one night stay in Batemans Bay.

## **DAY 2: Tuesday 7 May 2019 (B, MT, D)**

This morning we visit the famous Mogo Zoo, featuring an amazing collection of endangered and exotic animal species including the Snow Leopard, Red Panda, and Sumatran Tiger. After enjoying our morning tea here we visit Old Mogo Town which is a reconstructed village depicting life in the Gold Rush days of the 1850's. You will have free time to wander through the authentic buildings and static displays, art galleries and the various unique antique shops. After lunch we make our way to the stunning southern gateway to Eurobodalla – Central Tilba. Central Tilba is a perfectly preserved heritage village set amongst lush green valleys and granite punched outcrops. Hosting a charming selection of art and craft, gourmet produce, specialty stores and the award winning ABC Cheese Factory. Our last stop before we retreat is the beautifully developed Foxglove Gardens. Enjoy a wander through its floral delights or perhaps a bite of afternoon tea whilst enjoying the serene surrounds.

## **DAY 3: Wednesday 8 May 2019 (B, L, D)**

After a relaxing breakfast we will head off to explore the pretty coastal town of Eden. Set in magnificent Twofold Bay, we begin our day at the Eden Killer Whale Centre for a guided tour. Here we will discover the intriguing story of the unique working relationship between the whalers and Killer Whales. For lunch we will step on board the Cat Balou for a scenic cruise around Twofold Bay. Our afternoon will continue via the breathtaking Rotary Lookout before we visit the Wheelers Oyster Farm for a tour of the state-of-the-art factory learning the history of oyster farming, finishing with a delicious taste of the oysters straight from the lake.

## **DAY 4: Thursday 9 May 2019 (B, L, D)**

This morning you will enjoy some free time to explore the beautiful Merimbula Township before we head to the Merimbula Aquarium. Here we will discover the secrets of our underwater world before settling in to enjoy a delicious lunch, taking in the spectacular 180 degree ocean views. After lunch we will visit The Bega Cheese Heritage Centre where we can learn about the history of dairying and Bega Cheese in the Bega Valley, enjoy a fresh made dairy treat and explore the tools of the trade in the onsite museum.

## **DAY 5: Friday 10 May 2019 (B, MT, L, D)**

After breakfast this morning we travel through to Bombala to visit the grand Victorian themed Burnima Homestead for a guided tour. The 32 room house has now been fully restored to its original condition, presenting a working example of the country lifestyle of the 1800's in Australia. After a delicious homestyle morning tea here we will make our way to the historic red brick Lavender House at Railway Park. Once the convent for the sisters of St. Joseph, it now houses a beautiful array of locally produced lavender products and local historic information. Here we will also enjoy a distillation demonstration. For lunch we will head into town to enjoy a comforting meal at the local Bombala RSL Club. The afternoon will continue at the Delegate History Museum providing us with an interesting snapshot of the social and economic history of the village which is shared next door at the Bundian Way Gallery via its exhibited art.

## **DAY 6: Saturday 11 May 2019 (B, D)**

This morning we farewell beautiful Merimbula and make our way North stopping at Cooma to visit the Snowy Hydro Discovery Centre. The state-of-the-art centre showcases the amazing history of the Snowy Mountains Scheme; from the early days

of construction through to today's operation by Snowy Hydro. After our tour here we hop back on board and continue to Canberra where we will visit the iconic Parliament House for lunch (at own expense) and a tour of the building.

For the afternoon we visit the Australia War Memorial for a guided tour, staying on for the Last Post Ceremony, where a Soldier's story on the Roll of Honour is shared around the Pool of Remembrance.

## **DAY 7: Sunday 12 May 2019 (B, L)**

This morning we continue on our journey back home stopping at Goulburn to enjoy some morning tea and see the World's Biggest Merino. The grand structure stands at 15.2 metres high, 18 metres long and was built in 1985 as a celebration of Australia's Fine Wool Industry. After a lunch stop at Highlands Golf Club in Mittagong we continue on to Mount Penang Gardens on the Central Coast. Here we will enjoy a little wander through the exquisite individual gardens or perhaps an afternoon cuppa at the Waterfall Cafe nestled over the cascading ponds and waterlilies before our arrival back home.
