The locals love it and visitors travel from all over the country to be part of it. Now in its 69th year the award-winning Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers continues to grow. Spectacular gardens, country touring, live music and local food & wine plus much more.

DAY 1: Monday 23th September 2019 (MT,L,D)

After boarding our Port Stephens Coach we begin making our way up the New England Highway stopping for morning tea in Muswellbrook before continuing to Tamworth, otherwise known as Australia's 'Capital of Country Music'. Lunch will be at the famous Big Golden Guitar Tourist Centre. The monument is one of the best-known points of interest in New England. Our visit includes entry into the Gallery of Country Music Stars Wax Museum where all the life-like figures are beautifully and carefully constructed and carved. They are dressed in the original clothing and displayed in a setting reflects in the time and person, their lives and their music. If you prefer, you can visit the Collectors Museum featuring Sir Donald Bradman which is the largest privately owned collection of Bradman memorabilia. After lunch we continue our journey to Armidale where we will enjoy some free time before checking into our accommodation.

DAY 2: Tuesday 24th September 2019 (B,MT, L,AT,D)

This morning we continue travelling north, stopping for morning tea along the way. Arriving at Wallangarra we visit the Wallangarra Railway Station Café for lunch and a stroll through the onsite museum before continuing on the road again. On arriving in the picturesque town of Toowoomba, we have a special surprise for afternoon tea. We will then check into our motel which will be our home for the next three nights.

DAY 3: Wednesday 25th September 2019 (B,MT,L,D)

A full day to enjoy the Carnival of Flowers in Toowoomba. We'll visit several competition gardens in the area as well as morning tea in the Japanese Gardens. Lunch will be enjoyed in Laurel Bank Park, supplied by Laurel Bank Park Croquet Club. After lunch, we take in the breathtaking beauty of Queens Park Gardens before a visit to Toowoomba Information Centre. We then return to the motel for the night to enjoy a relaxing dinner.

This morning we head to Toowoomba Train Station for a diesel-hauled train ride to Spring Bluff Station. Heritage-listed Spring Bluff Railway Station is home to 150 years of railway history and beautifully landscaped gardens. The splendour of the gardens will stop you in your tracks! We'll visit more competition gardens before heading to Meringandan Hotel for lunch. This afternoon we'll enjoy a country drive to visit another competition garden before heading into town for free time exploring the many retail delights of Toowoomba City.

DAY 5: Friday 27th September 2019 (B,MT,L,D)

After breakfast, we farewell Toowoomba and make our way to Goondiwindi where we'll enjoy a tour of Customs House Museum before lunch. You'll also get the chance to check out the statue of Gunsynd, the Goondiwindi Grey - Goondiwindi's history-making racehorse. This afternoon we visit the Narrabri Shire Visitor Information Centre where all visitors are invited to drive the cotton picker located in the centre. There is fabulous local produce including cotton products, oils, lotions, soaps and general souvenirs. Other merchandise available includes beautiful Linen Press, Tall Poppy Gourmet, local Jojoba products, lavender products, and honey, as well as the unique Pilliga Pottery.

DAY 6: Saturday 28th September 2019 (B,MT,L)

Departing Narrabri on our last day of the tour, we continue our travels stopping for morning tea before arriving at the Hunter Belle Cheese Café situated on the outskirts of the Hunter Valley in the town of Muswellbrook. Treating our taste buds to a selection of gourmet sandwiches and wraps followed by a cheese tasting of Hunter Belle's premium cheese selections. Have a wander through the gourmet produce, specialty giftware and library of culinary books or indulge in a scoop of the café's creamy gelato, made in-house before we hop back on board the coach returning home from a beautiful time away.
